Lars Gullin *A Discography*

This discography of the famous Swedish baritone saxophonist and composer LARS GULLIN started as a private compilation in the 1970s with the help of Lars Gullin and other musicians who added valuable information. A printed version appeared in the Lars Gullin biography *Jazz Amour Affair* in 1986. A CD-only version has been available on the web site www.gullin.net, but this has not been updated for years since the author has been occupied with this complete and up to date version of the discography. It has been a period with a steady influx of new CD reissues, but also years of adding odd items and removing some pre-announced records that were never issued.

This work presents a complete survey of all the recordings Lars Gullin made. It covers everything from his debut with the Arthur Österwall Sextet in 1949 to the final recording of his *Aeros Aromatica Suite* in 1976.

The book includes an extensive biography of Gullin. There are also some photographs which show Gullin in different points in his career.

The work is thoroughly indexed with an alphabetical list of issued recordings (in all formats), a musicians and a song title index.

The book is wirebound with xii+105, size 14.5×21 cm pages. It is available from most jazz specialist shops, as well as from major jazz mail order services, or directly from the address below (€ 27.50, plus tax, postage and handling). ISBN 90-77260-07-2.
